

AEGIS is newest Renaissance affiliate

The national board of Renaissance has accepted another organization as an affiliate: the Atlanta Educational Gender Information Service (AEGIS) of Atlanta, a not-for-profit organization which disseminates information to persons interested in issues of gender.

AEGIS provides free referrals to support groups and gender clinics as well as free referrals to physicians, psychologists, psychiatrists, social agencies and private social workers, ministers, and attorneys to those people not within range of a gender support group.

The organization recently hosted a private reception in honor of Carolyn Crossey (Tula), welcoming her to Atlanta. Crossey is reportedly moving to the United States and will open a business in the Atlanta area.

The organization's publications include the *Chrysalis Quarterly*,

published four times a year, a series of booklets to aid in gender transition, and other publications in preparation.

AEGIS was founded by and is managed by Dallas Denny, M.A., a human service professional with knowledge of the professional

literature of gender issues and more than a decade of experience in the delivery of psychological services.
