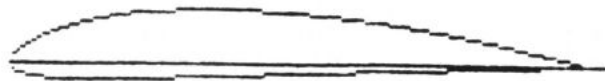
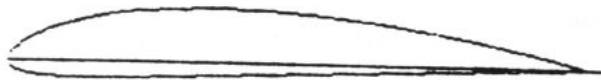


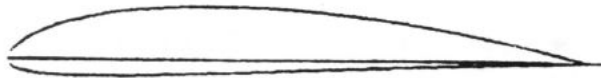
Fig. 2 Airplane Wing Section
